\$1 MILLION BOND ON APRIL 7 BALLOT:

Please plan to vote April 7. On the ballot is a \$1M bond to partially pay for refurbishing the wastewater plant. To proceed with the projected \$4M project, the City must pass this bond to receive state grants. In mid-March activated sludge was installed to break down the solids and aeration is feeding the activated sludge to lower BOD and ammonia to come into compliance with DNR regulations.
