DATE CHANGES FOR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS: Council meetings will be held on the 2ND TUESDAYS starting May 12.

1M BOND PASSED: Thank you citizens for passing the bond April 7. That brings the amount in bonds to \$4.1M needed for renovations of the wastewater plant. In mid-March activated sludge and aeration were added to the plant's system plus the trickle wheel is in working order. These improvements are bringing the numbers closer to DNR regulations so hopefully all the bonds will not need to be used to bring the plant into compliance.
